Diocesan-Parish Annual Appeal

Thank you to everyone who has made a pledge or gift to this year's DPAA. This annual appeal is our way of sharing in the many ministries so many of our brothers and sisters need. When we make a sacrificial offering to the DPAA we are accepting our small place within the Body of Christ and our responsibility within the larger Church.
