**Reflection...**When we make mistakes or even when we fail willfully and grievously, we tend to excuse ourselves and plead that we are "only human," by which we mean weak and fallible. Jesus knows we are only human. He also asks, in effect, that we try to be like God by imitating God's compassion. He does not command us to take things into our own hands, to even the playing field, to exact an eye for an eye or a tooth for a tooth. The God of Jesus does not keep books. God's business is kindness and mercy, and this is to be our business.

The responsorial psalm readies us for this good news proclaimed today. We sing of a God who pardons, heals, redeems, is slow to anger and rich in kindness. These are the true acts of God. And these are the very acts we are to imitate in our dealings with one another. The compassion and mercy that most perfectly describe God must also describe us. That is Jesus' command to us today: "Be merciful, as your Father is merciful."

**Diocesan-Parish Annual Appeal...**St. Joseph is nearing its Annual Appeal goal. As of this week, with **438** families donating, our DPAA total has reached **\$103,562.12**. We are now within \$15,000 of our \$118,400 parish goal. All of the funds collected exceeding our parish goal will be rebated back to us. This rebated money can then be used to fund improvements to our facilities and grounds.
