Newport Central Catholic Class of 2010 earns \$5.1 Million in College Scholarships....

The class of 2010 from Newport Central Catholic, 70 of the 106 or 66 percent of the class, earned over \$5.1 million in college scholarships. Of the school's 106 graduates, 102 plan to continue their education by attending 18 different colleges and universities, and 9 graduates plan to continue their athletic careers at the college level. Notably, 2 graduates earned Governor Scholar status, and 40 graduates are members of the National Honor Society. Of the graduates, 64 or 60% percent of the class successfully completed 1 or more Advanced Placement Courses during their 4 years of study. In addition, 37 graduates successfully completed 1 or more Advanced Placement Courses during their senior year.
