St. Joseph to have after school program available this coming year.....A recent notice about a permit for a “nursery school” at St. Joseph has raised questions for some parishioners. St. Joseph will offer an after school program for students in our school in the coming school year. Children’s Inc. will begin operating this program in the parish Activity Center. It is NOT a nursery. However, the No. Ky. Area Planning Commission places after school programs in the same category as “nursery schools”. That is why Children’s Inc. applied for a “nursery school” permit.

The after school program will operate from school dismissal until 6PM on school days only.

Diocesan Parish Annual Appeal THANK YOU!!

The parish received a letter of appreciation from Mike Murray, Diocesan Director of Stewardship & Mission Services. I want to share part of his letter because it expresses the significance of the DPAA.

“Thank you so very much for sharing your gifts with the 2010 Diocesan Parish Annual Appeal. The success of the 2010 DPAA is a tribute to our Diocesan heritage of generosity and dedication to the mission of our local church and to our ministries of service. To date, the DPAA has received a total of \$2,793,276 in gifts from 11,260 generous donors. These gifts will not only help the Diocese continue the spiritual, educational and charitable ministries funded by the Appeal, but will also help fund parish programs and services throughout our faith community.”

As of this week 585 St. Joseph parishioners have pledged \$123,392, exceeding our \$118,400 goal by \$4,992. All money collected over our parish goal is rebated back to our parish. These rebated funds will be used for various improvements to our grounds and facilities. Some examples; the roads in front of the Activity Center and behind church, leading to the lower lot, need to be repaired, outside lamps need to be replaced, radiators need to be installed in the music room.

Though we are accomplishing a great deal with our Golden Anniversary Capital Campaign, these kinds of ongoing maintenance issues need our attention. By the DPAA we participate in the mission of the Diocesan Church and provide for the needs of our parish as well.
