All Lectors and Extraordinary Ministers of Communion throughout the Diocese of Covington (whether currently serving or new) are expected to update their knowledge and skills for their respective ministries. Proclaiming the scriptures at Mass and distributing Holy Communion for the parish community are important ministries. Those who provide this service for the Church should continue to renew their appreciation for the significance of their ministry.

New Diocesan norms for Lectors and Extraordinary Ministers of Communion will take effect on the first Sunday of Lent next year, March 13, 2011. Attendance at one Diocesan Training Session and one short parish session are required for those who want to serve as Lectors or Extraordinary Ministers of Communion after that date.

Further information and a schedule of Training Sessions are given on a flyer accompanying this bulletin. As each session reaches its capacity it will be closed. The first two sessions are very close to us; Melbourne and Alexandria. So, I encourage our parish Lectors and Extraordinary Ministers of Communion to register as soon as possible.
